AFTER TWO YEARS OF PANDEMIC IMPROVISING, THIS SUMMER'S CAMPS WERE A BREATH OF FRESH AIR!

Our activities, family time, and worship focused specifically on how God loves our campers and how we can trust God, based on our verses for the year, Proverbs 3:5-6: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths."

Trust is not something that is easy for many of our campers, as most have experienced an ACE (adverse childhood experience) event in their lives. But God worked mightily!

We had 63 campers attend our two camps (34 in Tennessee and 29 in Georgia) and of those 63 campers (11 attended both weeks, making 52 different campers), 39 decided to follow Jesus at camp!

It was such a blessing to see them eager to learn about Jesus. In fact, one of our counselors recently sent us this story.

"One night as we were finishing up our small group time, I asked the group if anyone wanted to close us out in prayer. One of the kids shot his hand up first in excitement and said 'Oh, I wanna pray!' As we all bowed our heads waiting for him to begin, he paused and said, 'wait, how do you pray?' If was a funny moment, but also a really special moment for me as I got to teach him how to pray for the first time. Needless to say, he did a great job praying!"

Then there is Gavin. Gavin was living in a shelter organization and had recently lost his Dad due to COVID. In addition, according to the partner organization that brought him, his mom is a drug addict. During the week of the Tennessee camp, Gavin gave his life to the Lord!

How exciting to know that each and everyone one of you helped make this possible with your support! Along with enabling us to pour into the campers spiritually, your giving also supplied some basic needs (sheets, blankets, toiletries, etc) for many of our campers AND extra fun. At the Tennessee camp, we were given the opportunity to let the campers make Hobo stew one evening for dinner and visit Dollywood for the day. Dollywood provided the tickets, but YOU provided the means to get there as well as well as the means to feed them lunch on that day. On our post camper survey, almost every Tennessee camper stated that going to Dollywood was one of the biggest highlights of their week.





We were also able to provide bookbags to our Georgia campers. Every Georgia camper left camp with a brand-new bookbag, ready to start the upcoming school year in style. This gives our campers a sense of pride and feelings of acceptance at school.




